Mid-Week 5 A Side Pennants

Our Grade B Red side is the Midweek Champions for 2019.

The finals were played at Wenty Leagues on Wednesday 14 August, and we were represented by Tony Yard and Warren Phillips (S) in the pairs, and Graham Krempin, Kel Sullivan and John Archer (S) in the triples. It was a very even performance, with all players contributing to the great win. Two others who contributed throughout the year to our success were Mick Hoban and Bob Sixty.

In the semi-final against Denistone, the score was 40 all after the 42 ends, necessitating an extra end. Due to great bowling by the two skips, the final score was 42-40.

The final against North Epping was also a tightly contested affair. After 10 ends we were comfortably ahead 21-12, but North Epping fought back strongly with the final margin being only 3 shots. The final scores were Pennant Hills 34 North Epping 31.

A unique double was achieved by Pennant Hills winning in both pennant competitions in the same year.

Since 2015, Pennant Hills has made the post sectionals on 5 occasions, "coming up with the goods" 3 times – a club record.
