Wattle we possibly be able to discuss in this edition I hear you ask.

Actually a Circular has come about jointly from Women's Bowls NSW & Bowls NSW regarding lawn bowls activity due to NSW Premier announcing the easing of a stay at home restriction this week. Here is an extract from the Circular.

It must be noted that the NSW Government has not relaxed restrictions as to:

- Social distancing (this remains that persons must keep at least 1.5m distance from each other),
- Outdoor gatherings (this remains at no more than two persons),
- That aged persons or those with pre-existing conditions should stay at home or take extra precautions if they leave their home, and,
- That licensed establishments remain closed (except for sale of takeaway beverages and food).

However, Bowls NSW together with Women's Bowls NSW now advise that clubs may, at their own risk, and after satisfying their own legal and insurance responsibilities, allow the use of their outdoor bowling greens for practice/roll ups under strict guidelines.

NOTE: This does not mean members can now go to the club and have a roll up/practice. Our President, Margaret and the Men's President, Kel are in consultation with the CEO of Seven Hills Toongabbie RSL to ascertain how best to manage this initiative. We may well have additional guidelines to be followed. Please be patient as this is not a simple process and we are working together to make this possible & most importantly SAFE!!!
